1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The afore mentioned Clubs, hereafter called the PROMOTERS will conduct the SA Reliability Trials Championship Series for Solo and Sidecar machines at the above mentioned venues, on the above mentioned dates.

The "Hardi 24hour Trial" will be conducted as round 4 in the Championship Series, but the **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS** shall be issued separate from these series regulations. Entries received **ONLY** through MA Ridernet.

2. JURISDICTION:

2.1. The abovementioned meetings has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Numbers RND 1: C21108 , RND 2: C21109 , RND 3: C21110 , RND 4: C21111 , RND 5: C21112 , RND 6: C21113 , RND 7: C21114 and is open to holders of current Annual Senior National Licence, and Once Event Senior National Licences. Annual and One Event Recreational Licences, (for Rally class only).

2.2. The meetings will be held in accordance with the current MA Manual of Motorcycle Sport, the SA Reliability Trials Supplementary Rule Book, these Supplementary Regulations, and, any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

BY ENTERING THESE MEETINGS ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1. Entries shall be open forthwith by online entry **ONLY** through MA Ridernet and close 12.00am 8 days prior to the date of each round. Late entry fee applies.
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the above listed Clubs or Promoters, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
- 3.3. Only entries received on the online entry form and payment system will be accepted.
- 3.4. **NOTE:- ALL LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED MAY START AT THE REAR OF THE FIELD AND SHALL INCUR A LATE ENTRY FEE, THE FEE INCURRED WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANISING CLUB OR PROMOTOR AND SHALL BE OF NO LESS THAN \$30. THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ABOVE LISTED CLUBS OR PROMOTERS.**

4. INSURANCE:

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
- 4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

All events will provide a minimum of level 2 medical service as per MSA medical planning, medical service provider nominated by the club or organizing committee of the event.

6. ENTRY FEES:

- 6.1. ROUNDS 1, 2, 5, 6, 7 OPEN - Solo \$125, OPEN - Sidecar \$170, ROUND 3, 2Day Trial OPEN SOLO - \$170 OPEN SIDECAR - \$200, RALLY (If Supported) - Solo \$70 Per event, Sidecar - \$100 Per event. (plus \$30.00 for a one event recreation licence per rally competitor, if required).
- 6.2. **LATE ENTRY FEES** will apply as per section: **ENTRIES 3.4**
- 6.3. Rider number, Information and final instructions will be published on the SART Championship website and on the promoting club or committee website.

7. CLASSES OF COMPETITION

RALLY - As per Reliability Trials Supplementary Rules, this class is non competitive and will not be scored and trophies will not be awarded.

NOTE: A restricted number of entries will be allocated to the rally class in each event. Some events have a capacity limit for entries received, and may not be able to cater for Rally riders if the capacity limit has been reached. Open Class entries shall take priority over rally entries, the organisers then have the right to refuse rally entries if they are unable to accommodate the extra riders.

By entering these meetings all Rally Class machines need only to comply with the South Australian Road Traffic Authority, but all riders in this class must comply with the current MoMS, the SA Supplementary Rules & these Supplementary Regulations. Any rally rider failing to comply with these rules will be **EXCLUDED** from the meeting.

Rally riders will only transverse the course in daylight hours and be limited to one lap of a 6-8 hour duration event.

8. AWARDS

Event and Series Trophies, and points awarded. Sidecar Rider and passenger will be awarded series points individually. Series Points awarded: Outright 1st 25points, 2nd 22points, 3rd 20points, 4th 18points, 5th 16points. All other positions awarded in multiples of 1 point to 25th outright placing. **NO BONUS POINTS AWARDED**

9. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 9.1. To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be no less than 6. Womens Class shall constitute no less than 4 competitors.
- 9.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and redistribute any awards and/or prize money, will be at the discretion of the [club or promoter - whichever is applicable], subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.

10. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 10.1. All machines entered must comply with the chapters "Enduro and Reliability Trials" in the 2021 M.A. Manual of Motorcycle Sport, and the 2021 SA Reliability Trials Supplementary Rule Book.
- 10.2. Multiple entry of the one machine in different classes of competition is not permitted.

- 10.3. All Machines entered must comply with the road traffic authority and must be road registered or permitted.
- 10.4. All Machines, equipment and protective clothing must start in clean and good condition. If any machine, equipment or clothing is considered to be not clean when presented for scrutineering, the competitor will be EXCLUDED from starting the event.
- 10.5. All Machines are exempted from the Fitting of Directional Indicator Lights, Chain Guards and Pillion Passenger Footrests. South Australian Government Gazette Issue No.42 Page3072. Copy of the Gazette at sartchampionship.com [Comp Info]

11. STARTING ORDER:

As per recommendations in the 2021 SA Reliability Trials Supplementary Rule Book.

12. RIDERS' BRIEFING:

A riders' briefing will be held half an hour prior to the commencement of the first riders starting time, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Details will be included in the final instructions. Riders Briefing Sign on sheets must be signed by the competitor as confirmation of attendance. Machine Examination shall close 30 minutes after the first riders starting time, unless stated otherwise in the organising Club or Committee's, final rider notes or final riders briefing on the day.

- 12.1. **SIGN ON:** At each round all riders will be required to sign on with their current
- Proof of National MA Licence.
 - Proof of Registration or receipt of payment.
 - Civil Drivers Licence.
 - Entrants Licence (where applicable).
 - Proof of club membership.
 - Log Book.
- NOTE:** Competitors are required to carry and maintain log books to be presented at each event, the book may be retained by the club or promoter along with MA Licence for the duration of their ride. Failure to produce a Log book will incur a penalty of 300 points.

13. RIDER INFORMATION

Will be published on the South Australian Reliability Trials website SART, the promoting club or committee websites or Ridernet.

Includes: Event location, Riding Number & type of number supplied by organisers (adhesive or plate type), Rider report time, Start time, Machine Examination Time, Rider Briefing Time, Fuel Dump Locations, and relevant information will be supplied. Rider (Numbers and starting order will be allocated by means of random draw and will be supplied by the promoter).

14. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 14.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 14.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.
- 14.3 For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be start of scrutineering with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

15. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - **CODE OF CONDUCT**, which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This **CODE OF CONDUCT** applies to all meetings and will be enforced. The code of conduct is available on the MA website, (www.ma.org.au).

16. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

The competitors will follow the marked course as laid down by the organising Club or committee, and will include 2 wheel tracks and natural terrain on private property also traversing made roads-dirt and bitumen.

17. STARTS:

At main control only, competitors can only start their machine when instructed by the starter or appointed official. Riders will start at one (1) minute intervals or as per SA Reliability Trials Supplementary Rule Book.

18. NOISE:

- 18.1 Machines may be required to undergo a noise emission test before or any time during a Trial. Noise limit while competing in a Reliability Trial is 112dBA.
- 18.2 If a machine fails it can be presented for re-testing several times.

19. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 19.1 All private property sections contain a hazardous route and should be travelled with extreme care at all time. The organising club reserves the right to abandon the meeting, refuse entries, plus alter the trial to suit entries and/or conditions on the day.

- 19.2. The organising club or land owners will not be held responsible for the possible removal or tampering with markers by any person/s during the trial.
- 19.3. An Environment protection plan has been put together which covers the use of enviromats used for these events. The protection plan is available at sartchampionship.com. When refuelling or replenishing other fluids the use of an ENVIROMAT is mandatory, and is to be placed in the correct position under the machine to prevent polluting the soil in the event of a spill mat size to conform to MA MoMS, and as per the SA Reliability Trials Supplementary Rule Book. Mats will be available for purchase at some events.

RESULTS shall be provisional for 7 days after first publication for competitors to review, the results will be then be published as final after the 7 day period. Results shall be published on the South Australian Reliability Trials website SART, and the promoting club or committee website.

EVENT & SERIES AWARDS will be presented at the end of the season, date and venue to be announced on the SART website.

20. EVENT FORMATS:

Rnd 1. Philip Haydon Trial - Marrabel

Hosted by the Gawler MCC the event returns to the Marrabel district. The trial shall be a Day/Night format of 2 laps and approximately 6 hours in total duration. - **Rally Class: If supported will be announced through Ridernet entry system.** Rally riders are urged to purchase a One Event Completion Licence, to ride the full 2 laps in the open field.

Rnd 2. Mike Connors Trial – Sedan

Hosted by the Keyneton MCC this round returns to the Sedan district, starting from the Sedan Recreation Park. The trial shall be a day time format of 2 laps, and approximately 6 hours in total duration. **This event has competitor capacity limit, and entry may be closed earlier if the capacity has been met.** - **Rally Class: If supported will be announced through Ridernet entry system.** Rally riders are urged to purchase a One Event Completion Licence, to ride the full 2 laps in the open field

Rnd 3. Lew Job 2 Day Trial - Robertstown

Hosted by the Velocette MCC this event, and will be run as 1 event over 2 days each day consisting approximately 6 hours in duration Start & Finish Robertstown oval, Sat Day/Night, Sun Daylight only. - **Rally Class: If supported will be announced through Ridernet entry system.**

Rnd 4. Hardi 24 Hour Trial - Kapunda

Hosted by the 24 Hour Trial Organising Committee Inc. Returning to Kapunda this pinnacle round will be a Day/Night format over duration of 24 hours continuous. Supplementary Regulations shall be issued separately. Entry through 24hrtrial.com, or MA Ridernet. - **Rally Class included** but competitors must hold an Annual Senior National Licence, or one event Comp licence. For more information on this event visit www.24hrtrial.com.

Rnd 5. Gil Harris Trial - Mallala

Hosted by the Levis MCC this event will be run in the Mallala district as a Day/Night format of 2 laps and approximately 7- 8 hours in total duration. - **Rally Class: If supported will be announced through Ridernet entry system.**

Rnd 6. River Murray Trial - Mannum

Hosted by SAPMAC this event will be a day time format of 2 laps and approximately 6 hours in total duration start & finish at Palmer Oval. - **Rally Class: If supported will be announced through Ridernet entry system.**

Rnd 7. Beryl Pearse Trial - Clare

Hosted by the Clare MCC. This final round of the series will be run in the Clare district as a Day time format of 2 laps and approximately 6 hours in total duration. - **Rally Class: If supported will be announced through Ridernet entry system.**
